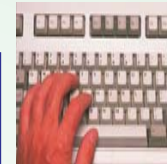

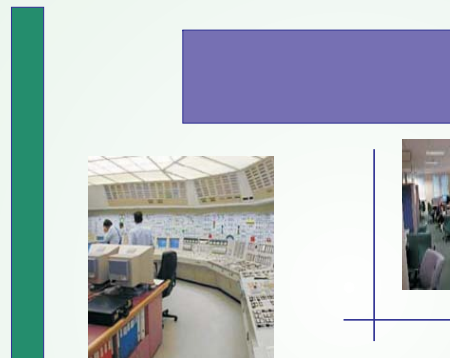


Advanced individual DSE assessments

DSE policy audit

Standard DSE assessments

What are the DSE Regulations?

The Health and Safety (Display Screen Equipment) Regulations 1992 were produced due to the increasing number of people using computers.

These Regulations came into force in January 1993 and were amended in 2003. Broadly their aim is to improve the safety of those people whose jobs involve significant use of Display Screen Equipment.

The Regulations require employers to assess and minimise the risks in computer work by ensuring that workplaces and jobs are well designed and employees are provided with health and safety training and information.

Training courses for assessors

For some organisations it may be more appropriate to use in-house assessors. So we offer a one day course designed to give current or new assessors the skills and confidence to carry out DSE assessments that the Regulations require.

The course finishes with each delegate conducting a DSE assessment under the supervision of one of our experts.
